

Minutes of September 11, 2006

Minutes and the financial statements of the previous meeting were reviewed and approved with no changes made.

Chris Grayson reported on the status of the school building projects. He reported the next several weeks would be crucial to pushing the projects forward. Later in the fall the booster club would be involved in coordinating a community meeting regarding the project at CHS.

Discussion continued again on the need for a new sound system in Dunn Arena. With school just starting and winter sports programs just around the corner it was decided to present to Dr. Rohr our proposal from Mom's Music for approximately \$9000. This system would be mobile enough to be used in a new facility if need be. Chris Grayson is going to present this proposal to Dr. Rohr tomorrow night September 12, 2006.

Prices for t-shirts was set at \$10 apiece and would be available at the next football game.
