At the beginning of the meeting David Wolfe from Star Physical Therapy gave a presentation on the need of a "hydroculator" for our athletes. After the presentation it was moved and seconded that Pirate Pride purchase a hydroculator.

The financial report was handed out by Chris Grayson on behalf of David Trotter who was unable to attend the meeting. It was reported that the checking account balance was \$33,141.24, and a handout of each sports account was given to its chairperson.

The minutes from the January meeting were amended to remove the word back from the section dealing with the money being put into the girls basketball fund, as it was originally put into a transportation fund, not into the girls basketball fund. With this amendment the minutes were approved.

The Cheerleading fundraiser with OVW wrestling was discussed, and it was moved that the booster club would upfront the \$1500 to buy the show. The only date available for the show is May 11. The Booster club would get reimbursed from the first \$1500 in profit. The remaining amount of profit would be used to pay for new cheerleader uniforms, and any leftover would be given to any sport that helps with the show.

Chris Grayson gave an update on the school building project, and the petition drive which runs from Feb 20-March 21. A meeting was scheduled at Grayson Funeral Home for Feb 19 to get organized on how to get the most signatures on the petitions.

Lynn McQuillen talked about a possible fundraising opportunity with Papa John's, selling concessions at various events in Louisville. It was unanimously approved that Lynn and Carl Chastain move forward with this and get more information on possible dates and how various sports would be involved.

A new way to increase Pirate Pride participation was discussed with a possible \$50 being given each month to each sport whose chairperson or coach attends a meeting. After much discussion it was determined that more thought and information was needed before this matter could be voted on.

David Null asked that from now on there be no objects thrown into the stands at any athletic event. This includes T-shirts, Frisbees, and balls. He said there was an incident at the basketball game with Eastern, and that these items could be given out at the door as people leave, but not thrown into the stands.

With no other new business, the meeting was adjourned at 8:20 pm
