The financial report was given by the treasurer David Trotter reporting a current balance of \$34,117 along with a handout showing current balances in each sports account.

Chris Grayson gave a presentation of the current status of the building project with particular attention given to the Charlestown High School project. He also request as many members as possible to show up at the board meeting on Tuesday night.

It was moved and seconded for Pirate Pride to pay the two video cameras and dock at a cost of \$1,063.82. The Pride Pride Club will also pay for 2 carrying cases and 1 tripod. Rick Myers purchased 2 batteries and chargers and has donated these to the club.

Brian informed the club of the upcoming Pirate Pride nights. January 20, 2007 has been set aside for the Middle School and February 16, 2007 is for the Elementary Schools. The desire for the club was to have a Pirate Pride night during both a boys and girls varsity basketball game. We were unable to get it scheduled for the girls because of conflicts beyond our control. The club will try to schedule this early next year to avoid possible conflicts.

Melissa Stewart brought before the club a fund raising idea for the cheerleaders that centers on Ohio Valley Wrestling. It was discussed that they could do this for a 75% -25% or they could buy the show for \$1,500 and keep all the profits. It was brought up that they need to check with City Hall about an ordinance prohibiting wrestling of the kind within the city limits. Ms. Stewart was to check this out and get permission from the school.

The club took concerns from the girls basketball program and their request to have the transportation fund that came from a fund raiser for a post season bus in 2006. Their request was to have the money moved out of the transportation and back into the girls basketball account so they can use it as they choose. After much discussion it was moved and seconded to do this.

Brian Davis reported that he is currently working with the middle school parent rep to incorporate their programs into the Pirate Pride now that we have received the blessing from the school corporation attorney.

Meeting was adjourned at 9 p.m.
