### NEW BUSINESS:

**Student All-Sport Pass:** Last year there was much discussion about how to get more students to attend sporting events, it was suggested to lower the price of admission for students. At the August Pirate Pride meeting, those in attendance were told there would not be a decrease in the cost of admission.

**Fundraisers:** Coach Romans ask for clarification on the number of fundraisers a team can do. Parents can do unlimited fundraisers as long as the students/players are not involved. Student/Players are only allowed to do one fundraiser. Sports with multiple teams (9<sup>th</sup>, JV & V) may do three different fundraisers as long as the same students/players don't participate in more than one.

**Irrigation System:** Coach Romans stated the baseball fields are in need of an irrigation system. He wondered if that was something Pirate Pride would purchase. The Baseball team would have to use their cost sharing request from Pirate Pride to help. The maximum amount would be \$1000. It was

suggested that Coach Romans speak to Ms. Carroll and/or Mr. Hedges about the school purchasing the system.

**Tennis Courts:** The tennis courts are in terrible condition. Ms. Carroll said the cracks are scheduled to be filled on Sept 2. The trees and weeds in the fence and net areas will be cut before then, along with the cattails growing in the corner right outside the fence.

**All-Sports Program:** A request was made to add Cheer achievements in the back with the other team records.

**Pirate Pride Handbook:** A new Pirate Pride Handbook will be distributed at the next meeting.
